Launching Home Equals

There are more than 1 billion people living in slums and other informal settlements worldwide, and they are not treated as equals. Their homes often don't have basic services such as clean water. They lack land rights and are the most vulnerable to climate change.

On May 16, Habitat for Humanity launched Home Equals, a five-year global advocacy campaign to increase equitable access to adequate housing, particularly in **informal settlements**--settlements characterized by poor housing, lack of facilities, overcrowding and insecure tenancy or residential status. Living conditions in informal settlements are generally poor, giving rise to health issues and crime.

We invite you to join us because of how important housing is to so many aspects of people's lives. Home equals education. Home equals health. Home equals safety and security for families and the larger community.
